Course title:	Jailor-Court Services In-service
Course number:	JCS0607
Course description:	This course will fulfill the Department of Criminal Justice Services mandated in-service requirements for jailors, civil process servers and court security officers.
Prerequisite(s):	Students below the rank of sergeant must be enrolled by a supervisor.
Course Requirements	
Introduction:	This course is comprised of four training modules. Each module is composed of several sections (classes). Students who complete this course will earn 27.5 hours of in-service training credit (4 hours legal/23.5 hours career development).
Requirements:	Students must read the material contained in each of the four training modules. After the student has read the material in a given module, he must take the module quiz. In order to successfully complete a module quiz, the student must score 70%. The student will be given two opportunities to successfully complete the quiz. At the director's discretion, a third opportunity may be granted upon the request of the student's chief, sheriff or agency administrator.
