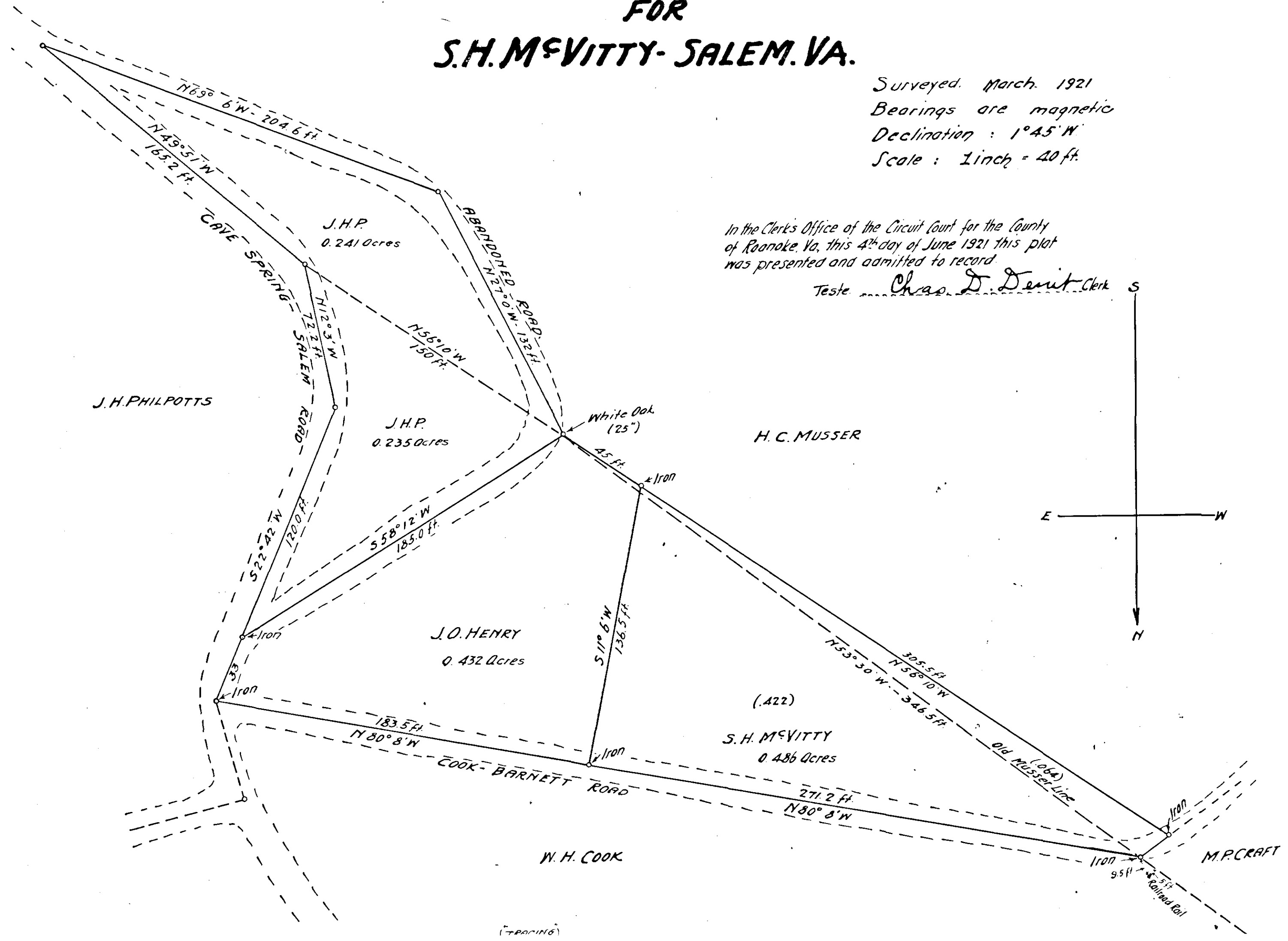


A MAP OF SURVEY OF RICHARDSON-BURNETT-MUSSER LAND FOR S.H. McVITTY- SALEM. VA.

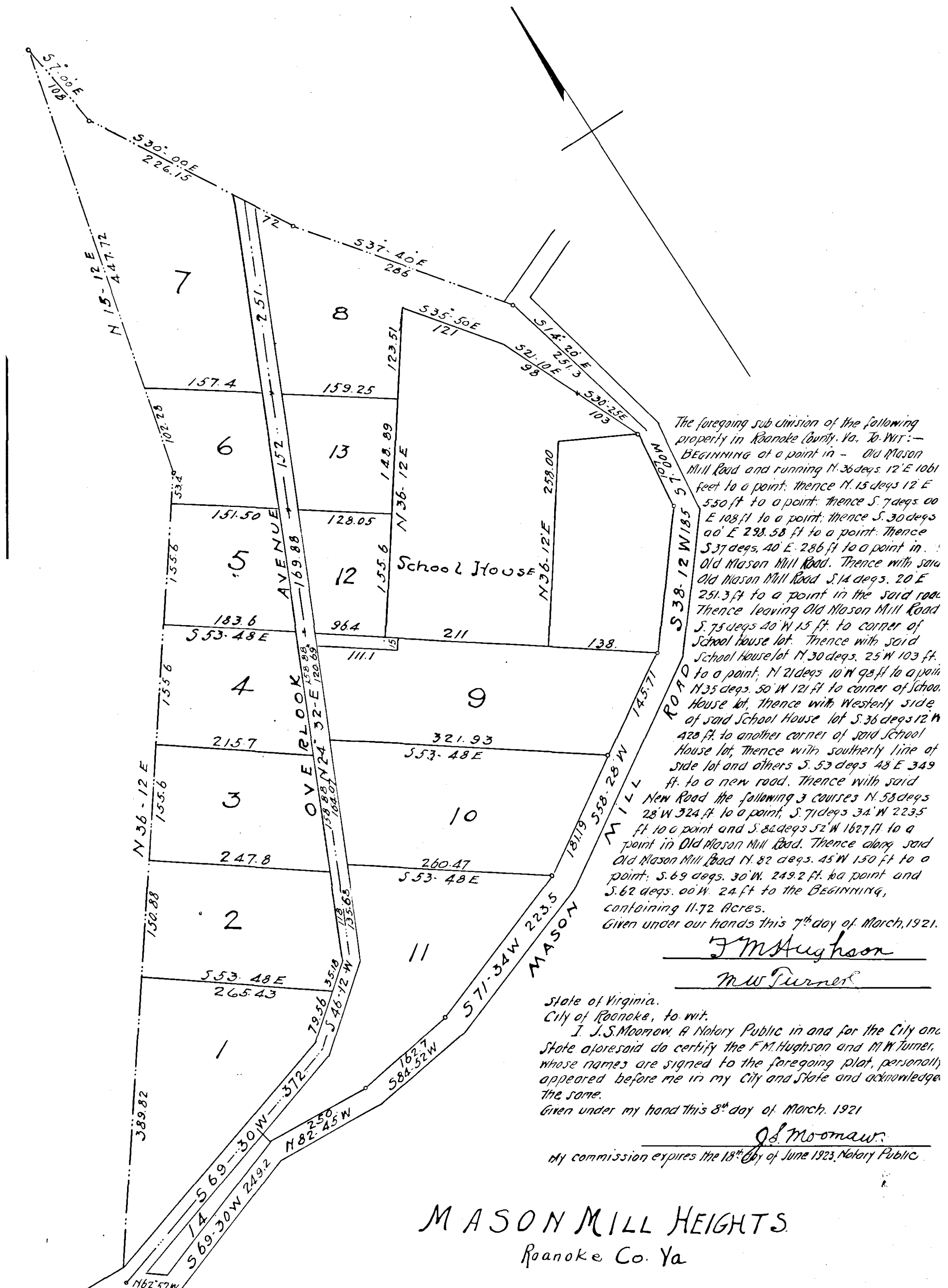

To Wit:— BEGINNING at a point in — Old Mason Mill Road and running N. 30 degs 12' E 100 ft to a point, thence N. 15 degs 12' E 530 ft to a point, thence S. 7 degs 00' E 108 ft to a point, thence S. 30 degs 00' E 230.58 ft to a point, thence S. 37 degs 40' E 286 ft to a point in — Old Mason Mill Road. Thence with said Old Mason Mill Road S. 14 degs 20' E 251.3 ft to a point in the said road. Thence leaving Old Mason Mill Road S. 75 degs 40' W 15 ft to corner of School House lot. Thence with said School House lot N. 30 degs 25' W 103 ft to a point, N. 21 degs 10' W 98 ft to a point, N. 35 degs 30' W 121 ft to corner of School House lot, thence with westerly side of said School House lot S. 36 degs 12' W 420 ft to another corner of said School House lot, thence with southerly line of said lot and others S. 53 degs 48' E 349 ft to a new road. Thence with said New Road the following 3 courses N. 53 degs 28' W 324 ft to a point, S. 71 degs 34' W 223.5 ft to a point and S. 82 degs 52' W 162 ft to a point in Old Mason Mill Road. Thence along said Old Mason Mill Road N. 82 degs 45' W 150 ft to a point, S. 69 degs 30' W 249.2 ft to a point and S. 62 degs 00' W 24 ft to the Beginning, containing 11.72 Acres.
