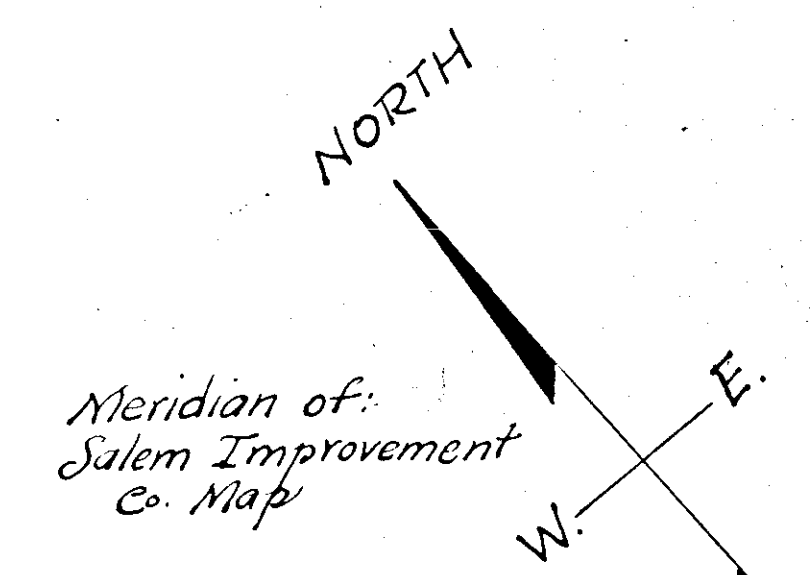
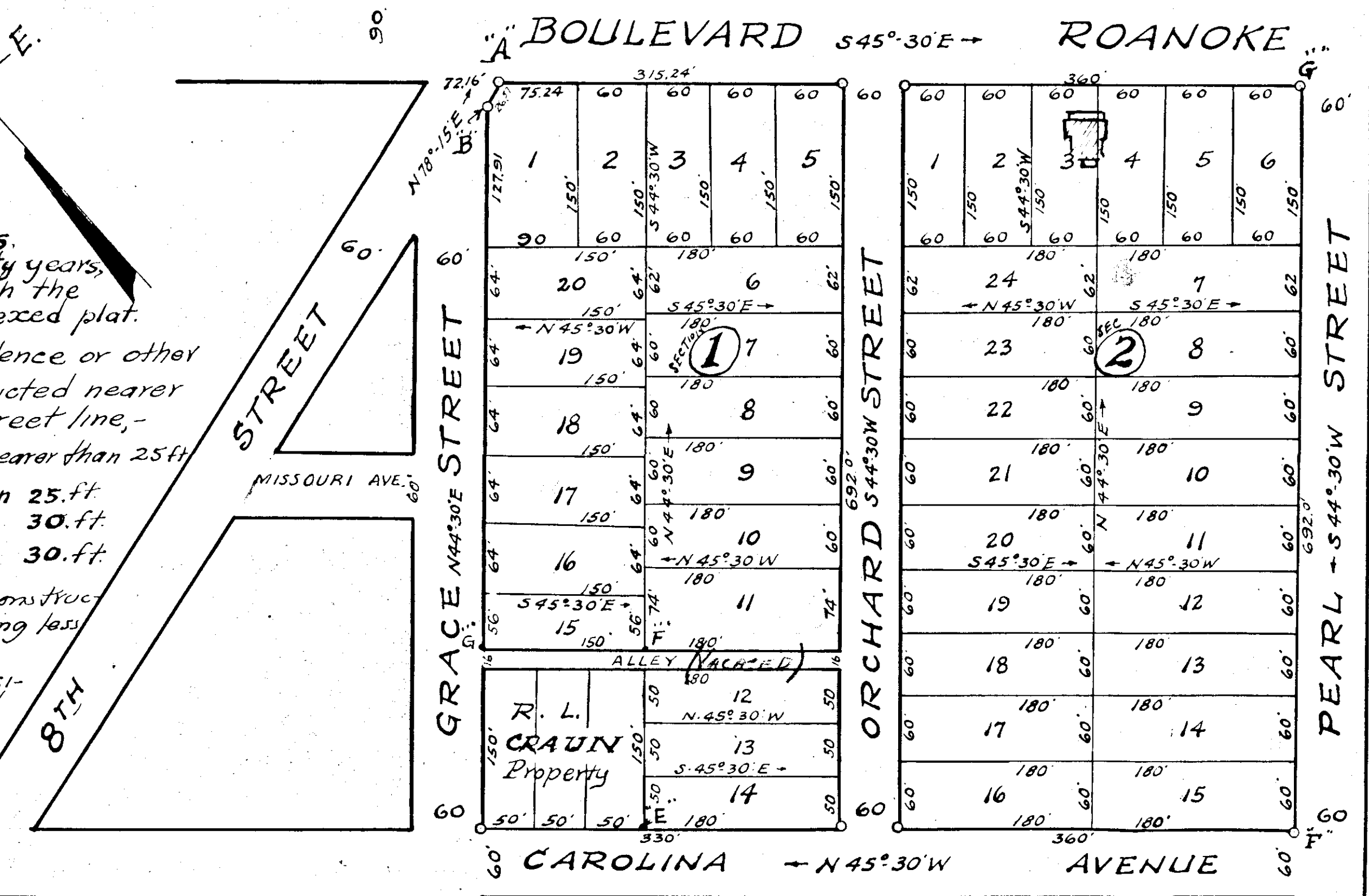




RESTRICTIONS.
The following restrictions, shall for a period of thirty years, be covenants, running with the land subdivided in the annexed plat.

- ① No part of any residence or other buildings shall be constructed nearer to the front lot line or street line, -
Facing Boulevard Pike, Not nearer than 25 ft.
" Grace St. not nearer than 25 ft.
" Orchard St. " " 30 ft.
" Pearl St. " " 30 ft.
- ② No Residence shall be constructed facing Blvd Pike, costing less than \$3000.00.
On other streets no residence shall be constructed costing less than \$2500.00.
- ③ No Business buildings, such as filling stations, etc., shall be constructed on any lot shown hereon, - which lots are to be used solely for residential purposes.
- ④ The lots shown hereon are to be sold or resold only to those whose nationality is of the Caucasian Race.
- ⑤ Upon a breach of one or more of the foregoing conditions, within a period of thirty years, from the date of recordation of this Map, the property affected by said breached condition or conditions, shall immediately revert and title thereto vest in the undersigned, his heirs, executors or assigns.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS To Wit: That L. D. Fisher is the owner of the property shown hereon, with the lots owned, numerated, and known as BONVUE HEIGHTS, which property constitutes a re-subdivision of Sections *90 and *93 of the Recorded Map of Salem Improvement Company's property, which Map of Record in Plat Book #1, Page #22 1/2, shows that Missouri Avenue is closed or vacated, together with that certain Alley, situate between Boulevard Roanoke and Missouri Avenue, extending through the center of Section No. 93.

In so far as the street locations, lot locations, are shown hereon, the same supercede the aforesaid Plat of Salem Improvement Co., as appears upon the aforesaid Page 22 1/2 of Plat Book #1. The annexed subdivision is in accordance with a survey made by C. B. Malcolm, the outside boundary lines being designated by outside CORNERS "A" "B" "C" "D" "E" "F" and "G". At a regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Salem, Virginia, held **May 9th 1938**, all members being present, on motion the following ordinance was unanimously adopted:-

"Whereas on application of L. D. Fisher, be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Salem, that the Plat and Subdivision, known as BONVUE HEIGHTS, which constitutes a replatting of a portion of Salem Improvement Co's Map, (which is of Record in Plat Book 1, at Page #22 1/2 of the Records in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Roanoke County, Virginia) be and the same is hereby approved, and the Clerk of the Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this ORDINANCE on the original plat of the property of L. D. Fisher, which original is to be recorded in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Roanoke County, Va., and this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
